Memorial Weekend Sunday Church and Cemetery Services

Veterans and their families from the Webster-Dudley area are cordially invited to attend a Memorial Mass to be said at Saint Louis Church, Webster, MA on Sunday, May 28, 2017 at 10:30 AM.

Veterans, Auxiliaries, and their color bearers are requested to assemble in the church parking lot, beginning at 10:10 AM. At 10:25, Veterans will assemble in columns of twos and march to the entrance of St. Louis Church where they will be met by an usher who will escort them to assigned pews.

Upon the conclusion of the Mass, all Veterans will proceed in a procession of cars to Holy Trinity Cemetery on Old Boston Road, Dudley, MA arrival time ~11:40 to render Memorial Day weekend honors at ~11:45 AM.

THE PARADE WILL FORM NEAR THE ENTRANCE TO ST. ANTHONY CEMETERY IN WEBSTER AND WILL PROCEED PROMPTLY AT 11:00 AM TO WEBSTER TOWN HALL PLAZA FOR EXERCISES AT THE VETERANS COURT OF HONOR

Please remember that Memorial Day is **NOT** a time for celebration, but rather, a solemn day of commemoration; a day set aside to honor the memory of our dead, especially our service men and women who paid the Supreme Sacrifice defending the freedoms that we all enjoy. All parade participants, whether marching or riding on floats, etc., are, therefore, requested to give this very special day the **RESPECT** and **DIGNITY** which it so rightfully deserves.

WHETHER RIDING IN VEHICLES OR MARCHING PLEASE DO NOT THROW CANDY, ETC. TO ONLOOKERS; THIS PRACTICE IS NOT ONLY UNDIGNIFIED IT IS DANGEROUS! IMPORTANT:

Upon completion of the Memorial Day honors at St Anthony Cemetery, all participants ALL units must be aware of the fact that the parade will begin momentarily.

At **EXACTLY** 11:00 A.M., the **ENTIRE** parade will step off.

All units that are behind the Veterans contingent are, especially, reminded, to begin moving at a reasonable interval as soon as the units to their front have begun marching so as to avoid the possibility of large, improper and unseemly gaps appearing in the order of march.
