- a. **Toll Booth Request – Blessed Backpack Brigade – John Marsi motioned to approve the request from the Blessed Backpack Brigade to hold a toll booth on Saturday, August 31, 2019 from**

9:00am to 12:00pm at the town line near Webster. Kerry Cyganiewicz seconded. Vote 3-0-1 with Paul Joseph abstaining.

- b. Annual Town Meeting Warrant - The Board reviewed the Warrant with Article 5, Article 10 and Article 24 on Hold. Regarding Article 5 – Agricultural Advisory Commission – Approve Term Limits, Mr. Balukonis stated that John Briare, who spearheaded the Commission and proposed the Articles, is aware of the changes Town Counsel made and that they incorporated the two requested in the original request into one, Article 5. Article 6 will be passed over. Article 10 – Special Legislative Act, Department of Public Works was discussed. Mr. Balukonis stated he would like to speak on this issue and how the DPW would cost less. Paul Joseph stated that we must stress that no Enterprise Funds will be used for other purposes besides water/sewer. Article 34 is the Citizen’s Petition Article. Attorney Randazzo stated that his article can be amended on the floor and the main motion can be different. If it is passed over it cannot come back to Town Meeting for two (2) years. After discussion **Paul Joseph motioned to approve Article 1-33 as presented and recommended with the comments included in the printed warrant handout. Kerry Cyganiewicz seconded. Unanimous 4-0. Paul Joseph motioned to recommend that Board of Selectmen not approve Article 34. John Marsi seconded. Unanimous 4-0.**
